Filing and publication of DHHS FYE 2023 Audited Financial Statements

The Board of Directors of Doctors Hospital Health System Limited (“Doctors Hospital”) hereby notifies its shareholders of the following:

The Audited Financial Statements for the year ended January 31, 2023 were due to be filed and published on or before May 31, 2023. However, to allow our auditors additional time to examine our assessment of the collectability of COVID 19 receivables, the production of the audited annual financial statements along with the auditor’s report associated therewith were not filed and published within this time. Doctors Hospital therefore applied to the Bahamas International Securities Exchange (BISX) and the Securities Commission of The Bahamas (“the Commission”) for an extension of time in which to file and publish the said Audited Financial Statements. Both BISX and the Commission have granted Doctors Hospital’s request. Accordingly, the Audited Financial Statements for the year ended January 31, 2023 will be filed and published on or before August 31, 2023.

About Doctors Hospital

Accredited by Joint Commission International in 2010, Doctors Hospital Health System (“Doctors Hospital”) is the premier tertiary healthcare institution in The Bahamas.

Doctors Hospital was formerly named The Rassin Hospital, founded in 1955 by the late Dr Meyer Rassin, a leading orthopedic surgeon who opened the original 20,000 square-foot, 24-bed medical facility. The Rassin Hospital was the most modern hospital in the West Indies for its time and a longtime dream of Dr Meyer Rassin to provide quality healthcare to patients. A group of Bahamian physicians bought the facility in 1986 and renamed it Doctors Hospital. In 1993, the hospital completed a 50,000-square-foot expansion and then became a publicly traded company in 1999. It now has over 1000 Bahamian shareholders. Today, Doctors Hospital is a 94-bed multi-site health system comprising two unique facilities. The main hospital situated at the corner of Collins Avenue and Shirley Street provides a full range of inpatient and outpatient services. The satellite facility, Doctors Hospital West (formerly Bahamas Medical Center), is located in western New Providence on Blake Road.
